

Midtown Association Clean & Safe Program

Maintenance



The Midtown Association provides maintenance and cleaning services for properties within the boundaries of the district. Services consist of graffiti and sticker removal, sidewalk pressure washing, gutter and storm drain cleaning, as well as litter and human waste removal. Our maintenance staff collects debris from walkways and alleys, and works closely with property owners to reduce illegal dumping. The Midtown Association's maintenance team is also equipped to properly dispose of syringes and abandoned encampments.

The Midtown Association Maintenance Program operates from 7:00 am to 3:30 pm Monday through Saturday.

Safety

The Midtown Association Safety Program was created to improve day and evening safety in the district. The Safety Team patrols the district on bikes, distributes safety information, and serves as a liaison to the Sacramento Police Department. In addition, the Safety Team is available to assist with panhandling, unwanted loitering and public nuisances, safety escorts, and outreach. The Midtown Association also has a homeless outreach program designed to connect our homeless community to social services.

The Midtown Association works closely with the Sacramento Police Department to identify and prevent crimes. Working with the Police Department and neighborhood leaders, the Midtown Association strives to provide a safe and friendly environment for everyone in Midtown.

The Midtown Association Safety Program operates from 7:00 am to 9:00 pm Monday through Saturday.
