



Thank you for your interest in becoming a vendor at the Midtown Farmers Market! Here are a few requirements and considerations before you apply:

## APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

To be considered as a market vendor you must fall into one of the following categories:

- Certified Agricultural Producer
  - Certified producers must provide their certified producer certificate as well as any second certificates that apply

Artisan or Craft Vendor

- A valid business license is required for all artisan and craft vendors

Cottage and Hot Foods

- A valid business license and County Health permits are required for the application

## BOOTH FEES

The current Midtown Farmers Market fees are:

- Certified Agricultural Producer: \$55 flat-fee weekly per 10x10 space
- Artisan or Craft Vendor: \$67 flat-fee weekly per 10x10 space
- Cottage and Hot Foods: \$55 flat-fee weekly per 10x10 space
- Food Trucks: \$100
- flat-fee weekly per space

## HOW TO APPLY

- Click on "Apply to be a vendor" on the Midtown Farmers Market website
- Complete the profile
- Upload your documents
- Apply your profile to the Midtown Farmers Market

## THE APPROVAL PROCESS

- Applicants must show their product, in person, to the market manager at the market of their choosing before they are considered
- Applicants must provide a photo or diagram of their proposed booth set up before they are considered
- The market manager will consider applications based on market availability, product, and business requirements
- If the market is full, you may be placed on a waitlist
- If your application is approved, you must provide valid insurance before participation
- Applications are reviewed on an ongoing basis
