# WAYFINDING SACOG FINAL REPORT



Midtown Association is a nonprofit 501(c)(6) organization whose mission is to make Midtown the center for culture, creativity, and vibrancy in Sacramento's urban core.

#### **OVERVIEW**

In October 2023, the Midtown Association, in collaboration with SAFE Credit Union and SACOG, introduced a permanent Wayfinding system in Midtown Sacramento. This system features color-coded steel posts installed at 15 key activity centers including a central hub at the SAFE Credit Union Convention Center, providing users with real-time walking and biking distances to these locations. An interactive website, accessible via QR codes on the Wayfinding posts, offers insights into what visitors can find at each activity center. The installation of these Wayfinding posts promotes active transportation modes, such as walking, biking, and scootering, while also helping users navigate the district with confidence and discover key Midtown attractions.

The comprehensive communications plan, made possible through a grant from SACOG's Mode Shift Grant Program, employed various media tactics to promote usage, including social media campaigns, outreach efforts, advertisements, eblasts, and influencer partnerships. Additionally, outreach initiatives targeted lower-income residents through partnerships with federally qualified health centers and focused social media ads, ensuring that communications were inclusive and impactful. Communication strategies resulted in positive trends in micromobility data, indicating an increase in visits and engagement with active transportation options.

This final report outlines the promotional strategies utilized and presents data and metrics demonstrating the system's impact and the success of outreach efforts. Overall, the initiative has fostered a more connected and active Midtown community.

#### **VISIT COUNT**

In 2024, Midtown Association began tracking visitor counts at our 13 Midtown activity centers and key destinations, including the Memorial Auditorium and SAFE Credit Union Center. The first table presents data from 13 of our activity centers where Wayfinding posts were installed. The second table focuses on visitor counts for the SAFE Credit Union Center and Memorial Auditorium, which are influenced by the number of events and conventions scheduled each quarter.
