


BOLLARD INSTALLATION – NOTICE OF CONSTRUCTION

December 20, 2021

The Midtown Association is reaching out to share information of an upcoming installation of removable bollards at the 2300 block of K Street. The Midtown Association is making Midtown the center for culture, creativity, and vibrancy in Sacramento’s urban core through event programming, capital improvements, and advocacy efforts. Through active programming such as the Midtown Farmers Market, Third Thursday, This Midtown, and other block parties public streets are frequently programmed for residents, visitors, and businesses to gather for community events. Events often require burdensome traffic management controls like water barricades, active duty police officers and other closure infrastructure that creates a barrier for additional community-oriented programming.

Currently the 2300 block of K Street is home to events like Third Thursdays, Cinco De Mayo Festival, and Okotberfest. Through the installation of bollard receivers in the roadway at the intersections of 23rd and K streets, as well as 24th and K streets, event organizers will be able to close the street down more efficiently with less cost. The bollards will only be installed in the street when a special event permit is received, which includes advanced notice of the street closure for the event. A site plan is referenced below that indicates where the bollard receivers will be installed for future use.

The installation of the bollard receivers will take place on Monday December 20 from 7:00 a.m. - 7:00 p.m. During the installation there will be no vehicle or bicycle access on K Street between 23rd and 24th streets to ensure safety of the workers, pedestrian traffic to the area will remain unaffected.
